Founded in 1979, Theological Education by Extension in Zambia (TEEZ) is an ecumenical program of 9 Churches aimed at providing extension based theological training to Church leaders and ordinary church members in order "to prepare all God's people for the work of Christian service" (Ephesians 4:12).

TEEZ courses are by extension, which means the school goes to the students in their local setting instead of the students leaving their locality to go to the school. This makes the training cheaper and time effective because students don't have to travel everyday or look for accommodation. The training is also contextual because the students learn within their environment and context and can therefore apply what they are learning to their situation.

Each year TEEZ registers over 2,000 classes spread all over the 10 Provinces of Zambia, including the most remote areas. With each class averaging 5 students, more than 10,000 students study with TEEZ each year.

TEEZ Theory of Change

To realize the structural improvement and capacity development of the Churches and Communities, Theological Education by Extension in Zambia (TEEZ) has developed a threefold, integrated approach-Our Theory of Change.

- In the first place, our work as TEEZ focuses on empowering Churches to ensure that they demand quality services and engage in effective work of Christian services. This is to ensure that we have empowered individuals, Churches and communities.
- Secondly, we build on a supportive enabling environment (Partners, Individuals and Member Churches) in which all stakeholders are aware of their roles and responsibilities, work together and can be held accountable for their responsibility of fulfilling the mission of the Church.
- Finally, we ensure that affordable and cost-effective sustainable TEEZ programs are in place and utilized by all people in TEEZ Member Churches and communities. Thus, our Theory of Change helps us to realize this structural change.

TEEZ Course

All TEEZ Courses are by Extension, meaning that the Study Groups meet in the local setting. Thus all TEEZ Courses are immediately contextualized, since they are instigated, completed, and applied in the same context.

TEEZ Tutors Course

The Tutors Course offers basic teaching/training methodologies to those who can teach TEEZ Basic and Advanced Courses at the Congregation level. Registration and enrolment are open to everyone who has a passion for the teaching ministry in the church and those who have been trained in TEEZ basic and advanced Courses.



Theological Education by Extension in Zambia impacts communities and provides contextual theological training to Christians around Zambia by equipping men and women to serve as TEEZ Tutors. TEEZ Tutors are not teachers. Rather, they are trained to facilitate group discussion and aid individuals as they learn about the Bible, theology, and practical ministry skills.

TEEZ Training

To that end, TEEZ spends nearly two weeks of every month traveling to cities, towns, and villages around Zambia to conduct “Tutor Trainings.” These trainings provide local Christians with the hermeneutical and epistemological skills necessary to read and discuss the Bible and a pre-prepared TEEZ course. This training is conducted by three TEEZ staff members, and coordinated by local TEEZ volunteers. Upon the completion of the training, students would have learned how to learn and how to teach others to learn, which liberates them to fresh implementations of the gospel truth in their communities.

The Business Enterprise is a financial sustainability wing of Theological Education by Extension in Zambia (TEEZ). 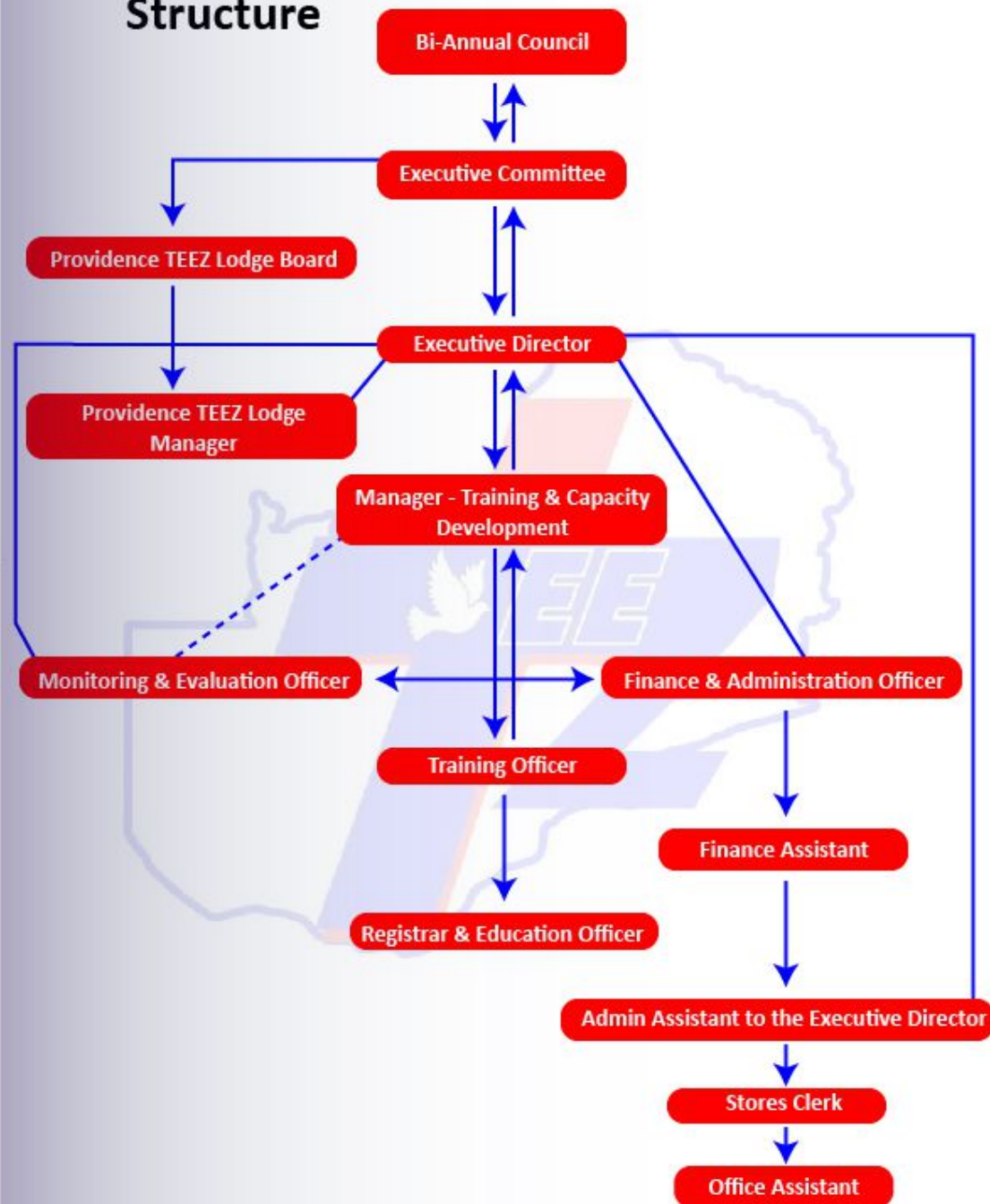

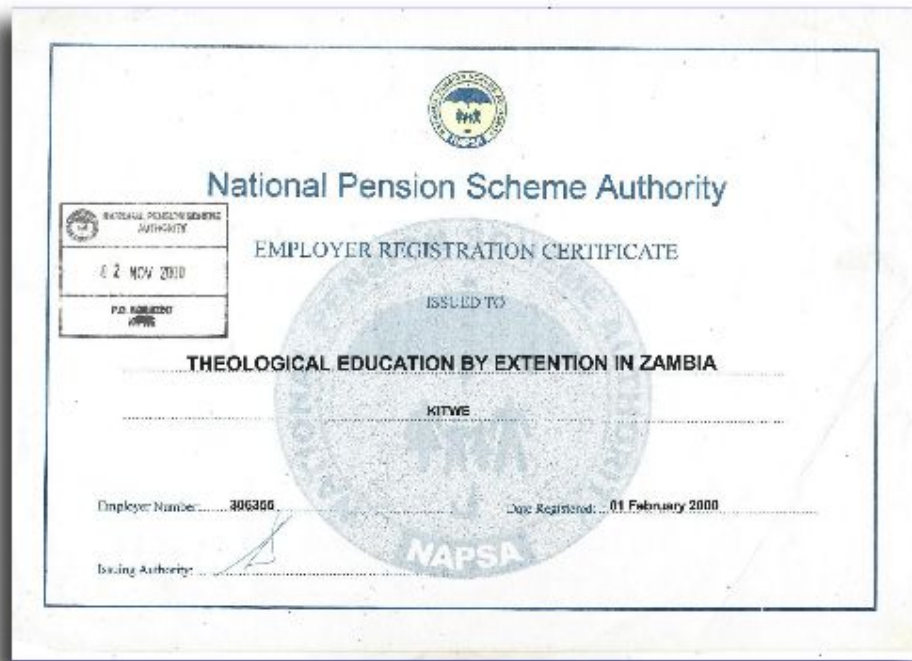
